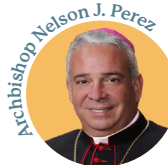

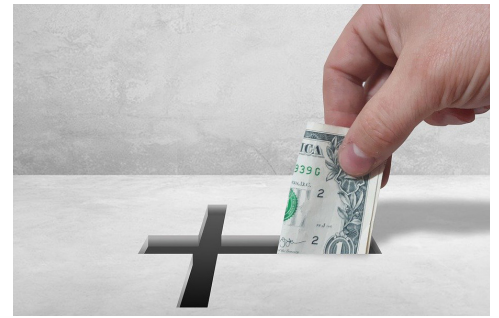

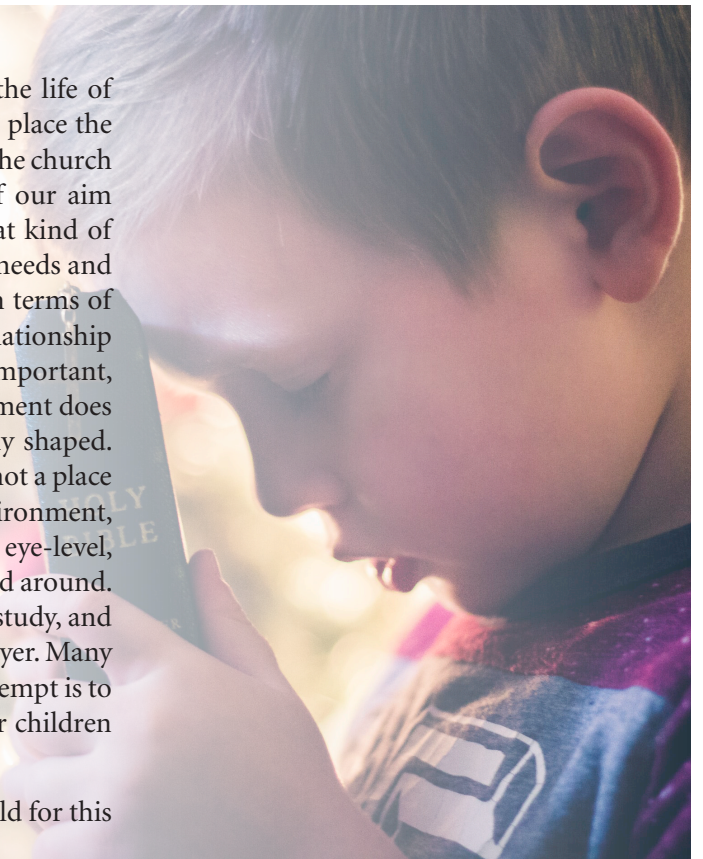

### CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD AND PARISH LIFE

#### A Place Prepared

In the early Church, the faithful were prepared for initiation into the life of the Church in a place prepared for the spiritual life. They called this place the "atrium." Just so, when children are prepared for the participation in the church community, the place should be prepared to help children pray. If our aim is to help children enjoy relationship with God, we must ask, "What kind of environment can we create that will respect and cultivate the child's needs and capacities at their particular level of their development, especially in terms of their spiritual development?" In a traditional classroom, primary relationship thought to be between teacher and child. There is, however, a third important, but often silent partner in education: the environment. This environment does not have to remain invisible partner, but rather can be intentionally shaped. This proper environment for religious formation is not a classroom, not a place of religious instruction, but of conversion. Upon entering the environment, one should see child-sized furniture, fine religious art hung at child eye-level, and representations of Scripture that can be seen, touched, and moved around. It should be a place of spiritual retreat for children. A place of work, study, and prayer, where work and study become contemplation of God, and prayer. Many parishes find themselves using rooms for varied purposes so every attempt is to be made to create a proper space for the religious formation of their children with careful consideration, creative ingenuity, and good stewardship.

# Disciple Maker Index Survey

## Spring DMI survey gives helpful feedback to the Priority Planning Process



Last spring our parish had the opportunity to participate in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) survey. More than 700 adults in our parish took the time to give their feedback, this puts St. Mary well above the national average participation rate which is between 7-10 percent of parishioners!

The Disciple Maker Index contained 75-questions designed to provide an opportunity for parishioners to reflect on their individual spiritual growth and overall parish effectiveness. Almost 300,000 Catholics at more than 1,500 parishes throughout 40 dioceses have taken the DMI since 2013, providing not just valuable data for each parish, but for the Church nationally, as well.

The Bulletin insert from June 27<sup>th</sup> included Diocesan-wide results. This summary includes highlights from the survey results for St. Mary Parish.

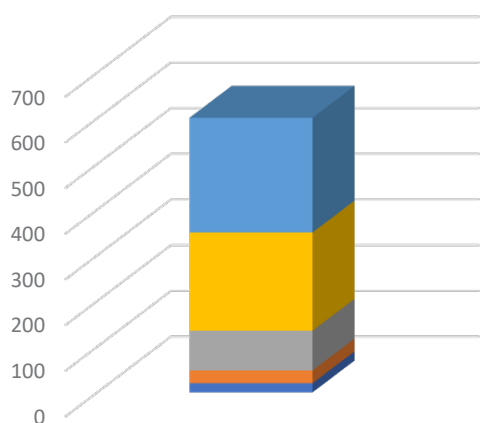

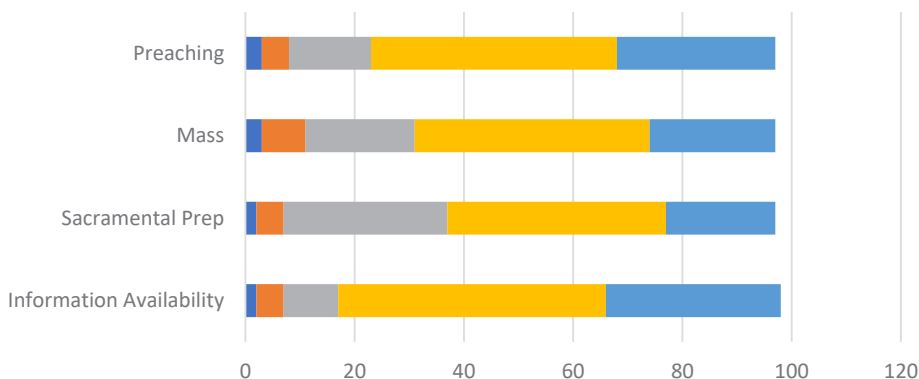

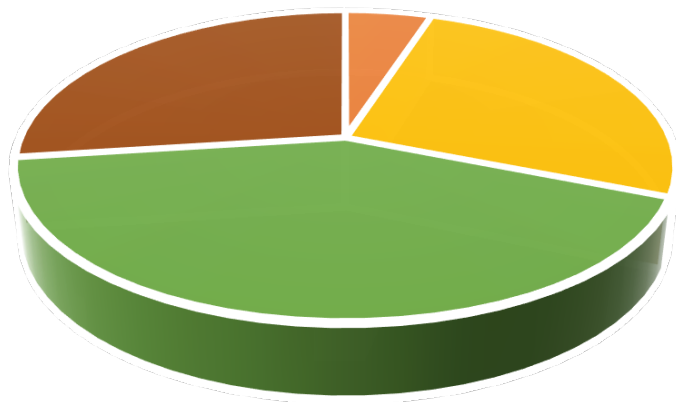

Dear St. Mary Parishioners,

As part of the diocesan planning process, all parishioners were asked to take part in the DMI survey at the beginning of Lent this past spring. The survey was not so concerned with measuring preferences, but instead was intended to give a snapshot of active parishioners in the areas of Catholic beliefs, participation in parish activities, and overall satisfaction. The survey also collected demographic information.

As with any survey, assembling the data is only one part of the process. Once we were given the data, I put together a “renewal committee” of parishioners to help me interpret and communicate this information to all of you. These are the members of the committee: Patty Barajas, Andres Bell, Cy Cottrell, Janine King, Andy Mackey, Renee Olney, and Steve Thieken. They will also assist me in the ongoing Real Presence, Real Future (RPRF) planning process. If you have not already, I encourage you to sign up for email updates on the RPRF website ([realpresencerealfuture.org](http://realpresencerealfuture.org)). Feel free to contact Andres Bell ([abell@delawarestmary.org](mailto:abell@delawarestmary.org)) if you have particular questions about the survey results or RPRF process.

This insert, prepared by members of the renewal committee, is meant to communicate some of the key findings of the survey. It is only a snapshot (and one taken during a pandemic), but it still provides valuable



data that will help our parish to meet current needs and to plan for the future. I plan to dig deeper into different areas of the survey in the future, but for now I would like to draw attention to one overarching trend:

We have received and accepted the essentials of the faith, but most of us do not feel comfortable sharing in the Church’s mission of evangelization. In other words, we believe in what the Church teaches, but we do not feel equipped to share that faith with others.

In the weeks and months ahead, I would like all of you to reflect on this information. How is it affirming? How does it challenge you? What opportunities does it present?

Our forebears lived in a culture that accepted and affirmed Christian beliefs, but that is no longer the case. We now live in times similar to the first Christians, who lived alongside a pagan culture that was hostile to their faith. As St. Peter counseled his fellow Christians, we must “always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks us for the reason for our hope” (1 Peter 3:15).

May the example of Our Lady, who brought Christ into the world, embolden us to share our faith with others.
