

The Pastor's Corner**HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY & JOSEPH**

My dear brothers and sisters, today we honor the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. In honoring them, we also honor all families. And in honoring all families, we honor the family of God, the Church. We are reminded of our two-fold status as members of particular families as well as members of the family and household of God. At the heart of the feast is the reminder that in becoming man, God in human flesh, Jesus Christ grew up under the direction of an appointed Mother, Mary, and a foster Father, Joseph, since His conception was accomplished with no human Father. The Father who gave Jesus life in human flesh is the divine Father, God the Father, the first person of the Blessed Trinity. It further affirms God's plan in creation for the fundamental role of the family, a loving relationship between a man and a woman through which new life is cooperatively brought into the world and nurtured. While we know that many children are nurtured without the full benefit of an intact family with both a loving mother and father, it remains fundamental to God's plan. We must endorse that plan and stand ready to help those unable to enjoy the richness of God's plan for the loving intact family.

Families did not come about by accident. The family is part of God's plan for us. God wants our families to be holy. The family is the basic unit of society and of the Church; we could say the family is a little church. It is in the family that we first learn to communicate. It is in the family that we learn what love is. It is in the family that we first learn to forgive and to pray. It is in the family that we first learn about God and Jesus and Our Lady. It is in the family that first we learn our values and what is good and bad. The future of humanity depends on the family because it is through families that society continues.

Reflect, today, upon your own family life. Some families are strong in virtue, some struggle with basic communication. Some are faithful day in and day out, some are broken and deeply wounded. No matter the case, know that God wants to enter more deeply into your family life just as it is right now. He desires to give you strength and virtue to live as the Holy Family lived. Surrender yourself and your family, this day, and invite the Triune God to make your family a holy family.

Finally, as we come to the end of the year, I want to thank all for your prayers and support. This first year for me has been both challenging, rewarding and an opportunity for growth. Since last January, by God's special grace, we have done a lot as a parish. We have shared our faith in Jesus Christ in many ways through the proclamation of His word and the celebration of the sacraments. We have kept the flame of Christian faith burning in our community. We have loved as Jesus commanded us to by supporting and encouraging one another through our many ministries. In the coming year, we intend to do more. We will use our many gifts to continue to enhance the kingdom of God in our community. To help me in prioritizing areas of focus, after Mass today, you will be receiving a form that invites you to prioritize the areas/activities you will like us as a parish to focus on this coming year. Kindly take your time and wisely help me with your suggestions on how to make our parish a home for all, where the love of Jesus and service to one another will be the center piece of our ministry. On another note, kindly pray for me as I travel to Nigeria to be with my mother, siblings and nieces and nephews. I will be gone for three Sundays. I surely miss you all. God bless you.

Charitable Distribution
 Do you know about the Qualified Charitable Distribution rule? If you are age 70 ½ and older, you must begin taking the required minimum distributions from your IRA or retirement plan. This rule allows you to send your required amount directly to a charitable organization such as St. Mary and avoid paying any tax on the amount. This rule also allows you to send up to \$100,000.00 per year and avoid the tax on the amount taken.



If you are interested in including St. Mary in your estate planning, there are also other tax advantaged strategies such as giving appreciated securities such as stock directly to the parish as well as using life insurance policies to transfer a gift.

 The state of Ohio has updated their list of EdChoice Scholarship eligible schools and **all Delaware City School elementary buildings** (Smith, Carlisle, Conger, Woodward, and Schultz), **Olentangy** Hyatts Middle School, and Libertry Tree Elementary, **Big Walnut**, Harrison Street Elementary, **Buckeye Valley East** Elementary School, **Marion City and Pleasant local schools**, as well as **Dublin City Schools** (Indian Run, Olde Sawmille, Riverside Elementary Schools) are on the list.
 If your child is currently not attending St. Mary School and attends one of the schools on this list, they can enroll and receive tuition from the state of Ohio. Other neighboring counties are also included. If you are interested in taking advantage of this opportunity, please call the school office or go to the Ohio Department of Education website and search EdChoice Scholarships. The process is easy and the scholarship will cover your child's tuition even if those schools are removed from the list in the future.

Liturgy 101 –

12 Catholic Days of Christmas – Part Deux

12 days are really only part of our Christmas observance, which also includes important feast days in honor of Stephen, a Deacon and the first martyr (December 26); John the evangelist (December 27); and the Holy Innocents, the infants slain by King Herod (December 28, Matt. 2:16-18). These are known as the *comites Christi*, “companions of Christ,” because their lives gave unique witness to Jesus through martyrdom (Stephen and the Innocents) and the written word (John).

Other Christmas feasts include the Holy Family (Sunday after Christmas) and Mary, Mother of God (January 1 – Which IS a Holyday of Obligation, nudge, nudge, hint, hint, not optional no matter how much festivities occurred New Year’s Eve). The liturgical season of Christmas ends with the feast of the Lord’s Baptism (Sunday after Epiphany) and the secular Christmas begins anew with the Hallmark Channel already airing Christmas movies for 2020. Speaking of Holydays of Obligation, we will pick up with those for 2020 next week.

- Confidentiality is essential.


