## PASTOR'S CORNER

### My Shepherd is the Lord

My dear brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

Our Responsorial Psalm is taken from one of the most popular chapters of the Bible; Psalm 23, the Lord is my Shepherd. This is one of the greatest chapters in the entire Bible. It is perhaps the most familiar chapter in the entire Bible among the people of God. Many Christians have committed this one to memory. This Psalm can fill multitudes of Sermons. It is a Psalm that cannot be exhausted. It is a Psalm that will give you what you need and encourage you in a difficult situation. Each verse of this chapter seems to practically minister to every need in life. It ministers to our deepest spiritual longings that we have. Countless numbers of people throughout many generations have found hope in it in times of great fear and panic. I will reflect briefly on the implication of what we say, whenever we recite this psalm. When we pray this Psalm, we are saying in faith: God is my personal Shepherd; God knows me; God provides for me; God restores me; God guides me; God protects me; God comforts me; God exalts me.

**God is my personal shepherd, He knows me:** This Psalm personalized God. We speak quite personally of God. We claim that the Lord is my shepherd and he knows me by name. God knows you by name, He has chosen you, and invites us to make chose Him. A good shepherd knows each and every sheep in the flock regardless of how big the numbers could be. God not only knows you, He loves you and cares about you (Jn 10:3-5).

**God provides for me:** The sheep obviously cannot voice out their needs. Yet the shepherd naturally knows the needs of each and every animal in the flock. The "green pastures" are the rich and verdant pastures, where the sheep need not move from place to place to be satisfied. The good shepherd knows every part of the field, even parts of the desert that would be green during the winter and spring. Even in summer and fall, the shepherd knows where the pasture is rich and healthy. God's care is not seasonal but constant and abundant. We don't need to worry about our needs because, just like the shepherd is aware of the needs of his flock leading them to green pastures and still waters, God is aware of our needs and how and where to meet them.

**God restores me:** There are many characteristics setting sheep apart from other animals. They are dumb, and innocent creatures incapable of defending themselves. Therefore, a well-informed shepherd frequently scans his flock for any fallen animals and rushes to their aid if he finds any. Needless to say, just like the sheep, we are also dumb and incapable of defending ourselves against Satan's schemes, especially because of the fallen nature that dominates our behavior. It causes us to fall into sin and later we wish that we never did what we did. At such times it is important that we repent and allow the Lord to restore us.

**God guides me:** A shepherd knows exactly where the best feeding grounds are and leads his sheep to those places. He guides us in paths of righteousness for His own glory and reputation. In guiding us, God shows the world that he is one hundred percent dependable and faithful. Most of the problems, if not all, we face in life are the results of not heeding God's guidance. We can enjoy every little instance of our personal life, marriage, career, and ministry if we are sensitive to His leading. He knows what's best for us and He will help us achieve our goals as long as they are pure and within the perimeter of His will.

**God protects me:** The phrase "shadow of death" portrays death as a deep shadow or as deep darkness. This image of death compliments the metaphor of the shepherd because the shepherd at times has to lead his flock to feeding grounds across ravines with sharp cliffs. Apart from the risk of a slippery foot, chances are these ravines are inhabited by wild animals like leopards. Yet, the sheep that follow in the path of the shepherd don't need to worry about cliffs or predators because the shepherd shall fight them off.

## My Shepherd is the Lord continued...

**God Comforts me:** The rod and the staff refer to a single instrument. It has 4 major applications to the shepherd. First, to fight off animals such as lions, and wolves that seek to prey upon the sheep. Second, the crook part of the staff was used to gently seize the sheep, that tend to run away, by its legs or neck and add them back to the flock. Third, it was used to examine the sheep. The shepherd uses the rod to pull the sheep's wool away from its skin to check for rashes, wounds, or defects. Fourth, to count the sheep. In the terminology of the Old Testament, this was referred to as passing "under the rod." Here the shepherd holds his rod over the sheep and counts each and every sheep that enter by the gate. What happens if he finds out that one of them is missing? He places others at the hands of a faithful servant and takes off searching for the lost one. The rod and the staff in all four applications brought comfort to the sheep. In our walk with God, this rod is none other than his word. The shepherd's staff is a symbol of authority over his sheep. Likewise, God's Word is a symbol of his authority over our lives which brings comfort when we voluntarily submit ourselves to it. In the light of the fourfold application of the shepherd's rod, His word helps us to resist temptations; prevents us from making wrong decisions; searches our hearts; convicts sinners; and leads them to the cross of Christ.

**God exalts me:** "You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever." This verse describes the Lord's faithfulness to His children even in times of great storms. The overflowing cup literally means "My cup is an abundant drink." It refers to a Shepherd's cup. The Lord cannot exalt us, honor us before our enemies, or ensure overflowing provision in times of storms unless we save both the battle and vengeance for Him. Jesus also commanded his disciples to love their enemies and pray for those who persecute them. Allow the Lord to be your Shepherd and the Lord will always be there for you in every situation and circumstance.

## Statement from Bishop Brennan on Prayers for President, First Lady

I join with civic and religious leaders from around the country, along with so many of the faithful here in the Diocese, in prayer for the President, First Lady, our nation, and all who have been afflicted with COVID-19 and its effects. ### **All Soul's Day, November 2nd**


