## **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament Friday, March 26th**

Throughout Lent, a different parish throughout the Diocese will host Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for Adoration as part of the *Real Presence*, *Real Future* initiative. St. Mary will host Adoration on Friday, March 26th after morning Mass from 10 am through 6 pm concluding with Benediction. We encourage all St. Mary parishioners and families, neighboring parishes, and Catholic school communities to pray before the Blessed Sacrament at all participating parishes. #### **Lenten Series on the Holy Mass**

Fr. Garland is offering a Lenten series walking through different elements of the Holy Mass to encourage a greater appreciation for - and active participation in - the Eucharistic liturgy. He encourages everyone interested (especially those who have not yet returned to Sunday Mass) to attend the Tuesday 5:30pm Mass and stay for the talk afterwards. There is plenty of space for social distancing at this Mass, which we hope will encourage more of our parishioners to return to regular participation in the sacraments. Fr. Garland will leave time for questions directly after each presentation. For the convenience of those who are unable to participate in person, the Tuesday evening Mass and presentation will be livestreamed each Tuesday on our Facebook page.

#### **Stations of the Cross and Reconciliation**

Stations of the Cross will be at 7 pm on Fridays during Lent. Stations of the Cross is a devotion during which the faithful meditate on the suffering and death of Jesus Christ on the cross. During this beautiful devotion, we remember the suffering that Christ endured for our sake as we retrace the steps of the last scenes in His life. "Living Stations" is a special depiction of the Stations of the Cross that highlights the talents of students in our 5th and 8th grade classes. The school is preparing a recorded version of the Stations to share with the parish as we are unable to have the live event this year.
