The Pastor's Corner

Trusting God even when we don't understand

My dear brothers and sisters, today is the last Sunday of our preparation for Christmas, the anniversary of Christ's birth. We are encouraged to welcome God's love with humility, charity, faith, and trust in God's goodness. We are invited to imitate Joseph and Mary, the humblest of the humble, the kindliest of the kind, and the greatest-ever believers in God's goodness and mercy. Christmas draws the heart of every child of God toward the furnace of divine love. In the manger, the infinite love of God for us miserable sinners is dramatically and forcefully portrayed before our eyes. In that helpless Baby, we know that the person, and the power, of the omnipotent Creator and sustainer of the universe lies hidden "He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave" for us. He became a creature, like ourselves, so that He would make us sharers in His divine nature. He came on earth to bring us to heaven. He hid His divine nature so that He could cover us with it.

I want to share my admiration for Joseph and the lessons he has for our generation. He trusted God even when it didn't add up in our human reality. Given the tradition of the Jews at the time of Joseph, he had the right to divorce Mary after he discovered she was pregnant. Even before the Angel of God ministered to him in a dream, he already had made the decision not to divorce Mary publicly. He did not want to bring more shame to her. This is being compassionate in Justice. And when he received instruction in the dream, he trusted God even when it didn't add up. This is a great lesson for our generation. We need to learn how to be compassionate as we pass judgment on others. We need to be graceful in how and what we think of other people.

In a couple of days, we will be celebrating Christmas. On behalf of Deacon Todd, Deacon Felix, Deacon George and the entire St Mary's Staff, I wish you a very Merry Christmas. A Christmas filled with love and peace. As we gather with our families, may this be a moment of grace, a time of reconciliation, a time of loving and supporting each other. On another note, I will be away for three Sundays from December 30th until late January. I will be spending time with my mother, siblings, and my ten nephews and nieces in Nigeria. In my absence, I will still be in contact with the office and every aspect of the parish life will be covered by different priests. I will surely miss you all. I will also be praying for you.

Finally, as we come to the end of the year, I want to thank you all for your prayers and support. This first year for me has been both challenging and rewarding with many opportunities for growth. My absolute gratitude goes to God Almighty. "Not to us O Lord Not to us, but to your Name give the Glory." I am also dedicating the coming year, as we consecrate our families and parish, to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and The Immaculate Heart of Mary. May the Lord Jesus Reign in our Hearts, families and Parish both now and forever, Amen. Merry Christmas and God bless you,

The state of Ohio has updated their list of EdChoice Scholarship eligible schools and *all Delaware City School elementary buildings* (Smith, Carlisle, Conger, Woodward, and Schultz), *Olentangy* Hyatts Middle School, and Libertry Tree Elementary, *Big Walnut*, Harrison Street Elementary, Buckeye Valley East Elementary School, *Marion City and Pleasant local schools*, as well as *Dublin City Schools* (Indian Run, Olde Sawmille, Riverside Elementary Schools) are on the list.

If your child is currently not attending St. Mary School and attends one of the schools on this list, they can enroll and receive tuition from the state of Ohio. Other neighboring counties are also included. The process is easy and the scholarship will cover your child's tuition even if those schools are removed from the list in the future. Liturgy 101 -The 12 "Catholic" days of Christmas

As we're reminded every Advent, our Catholic Christmas customs are somewhat at odds with the secular "holiday season," which starts before Thanksgiving and goes on until the last college bowl game (If you only watch 1 bowl game, I highly recommend to catch the Birmingham Bowl on Jan 2nd). But even though we Catholics wait a bit to get going, we have a similarly long season of celebration, of which the "12 days," made famous by a certain 12-verse carol (the best of which is hands-down the Muppet version with John Denver).

The 12 days themselves are simply the time between the two major Christmas feasts: The Nativity of the Lord on December 25 and Epiphany on January 6. Since Christmas was the major "birth" feast in the ancient Western churches and Epiphany was the biggie for the Eastern churches, the days between them inevitably gained significance. The St. Vincent de Paul Society recently submitted our annual report to our national offices. In view of the incredible support extended to our mission by the St. Mary community, we felt it appropriate to share some of the highlights of that report with you.

For the 2018-2019 SVdP fiscal year, our records revealed the following:



- An increase in active memberships from 29 to 35 members.
- 3,136 hours of time and 7,404 miles driven in performing the Vincentian mission.
- 323 person-to-person contacts, leading to 1,677 persons assisted by St. Mary/SVdP.
- The distribution of \$31,700.00 worth of life-sustaining goods to those in need, facilitated by parishioner support of the SVdP / PIN cabinet donations and our semi-annual clothing drives.
- \$109,403.00 of direct donations from our parishioners and supporters.
- The distribution of \$108,335.00 in direct financial aid to ease the distress of those in critical need of life's essentials.




